

SRS CALF SCRAMBLE PROGRAM

GENERAL RULES

A. The **general** rules shall be as follows:

- 1. The contestant for the current year may not have won a heifer in any previous year. A contestant that did not win in a previous CS event may participate again.
- 2. The heifer purchased by the winner shall have been calved the year of purchase. The participant must have suitable facilities for caring and developing the animal of their choice.
- 3. Participants may have to add more money to obtain the animal of their choice, as well as purchase feed and veterinary supplies required to care for the animal.
- 4. The participant must have a genuine desire and assume the responsibility of owning and showing a purebred beef heifer. Any USA recognized purebred beef breed is acceptable
- 5. The participant must remain active in and under the leadership of their current Idaho 4-H or FFA chapter throughout their entire Calf Scramble year (until next year's Snake River Stampede).
- 6. The participant shall maintain all of the records, as required by their 4-H or FFA chapter <u>and</u> submit monthly reports to the SRS office and their calf sponsor who made possible the purchase of the animal. The SRS Calf Scramble Committee will provide a report form.
- 7. Youths, ages 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 and not beyond beginning their senior year of high school, are eligible to compete.
- 8. We encourage participant to show their heifer at a county fair or any other livestock show during the year.
- 9. The participant will maintain satisfactory grades and attendance at their school during the school year, and follow the rules of their respective 4-H or FFA Chapter.
- 10. The participant will be required to return, with their heifer, to the Idaho Center during next years Rodeo Week the **Calf Scramble Heifer Show** and final meeting with the Calf Scramble Committee.
- 11. The SRS Calf Scramble Committee shall approve the sale or placement of the participant's heifer following the one-year commitment.
- 12. Any sale or transfer of a heifer during the winner's first year of ownership of his/her heifer is subject to the approval of the Calf Scramble Committee and return of the \$1,500.00 original purchase price to the Snake River Stampede.
